

**ORDINANCE NO. 876  
AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE  
ESTABLISHING A RECORDING FEE UNDER THE ELECTRONIC  
RECORDING DELIVERY ACT OF 2004**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, ordains as follows:

**Section 1. Purpose.** This Ordinance adopts and establishes a fee authorized by law, which will allow the County to establish an electronic recording delivery system for the recording of specified digitized and digital electronic records.

**Section 2. Authority.** The authority for the fee established herein is found in California Government Code Section 27397 (c) (1).

**Section 3. Fee.** The Assessor-County Clerk-Recorder shall collect the following fee:

(a) A fee of one dollar (\$1.00) for each instrument that is recorded by the County.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after the date of adoption.
